

Student and School Personnel Cards

Pursuant to Indiana Code 36-12-2-25, students currently enrolled in Loogootee Community Schools, located in the library district and homeschool students who reside in un-served areas of Martin County, may, with parental signature, be issued a student card at no charge to be used at the library.

Proof of current enrollment in or any non-public school located in the library district such as a report card or mail from the school to the student from current school year, is required. Parent or guardian must provide current photo identification and identification stating their current address of residency as defined above. Parent or guardian identification also applies to homeschool students. Currently enrolled students 18 and older may be issued a borrower's card without parental signature by presenting photo identification and proof of address of residency as defined above.

Current school personnel of Loogootee Community Schools and any non-public school located in the library district who reside in un-served areas of Martin County may be issued a school personnel card at no charge. As proof of employment, the customer must show a current school issued photo identification card or another form of proof of employment.

All student cards and school personnel cards expire a year from date provided and must be renewed annually.
